Total Grants and Scholarships:

Student aid funds that do not have to be repaid. Grants are often need-based, while scholarships are usually merit-based.

Loans:

Borrowed money that must be repaid with interest. Loans from the federal government typically have a lower interest rate than loans from private lenders. Federal loans, listed from most advantageous to least advantageous, are called Direct Subsidized Loans, Direct Unsubsidized Loans, and Direct PLUS Loans. Percentage of full-time students who graduate within 6 years - 59.9%
