GLOSSARY

Total Grants and Scholarships:

Student aid funds that do not have to be repaid. Grants are often need-based, while scholarships are usually merit-based.

Loans:

Borrowed money that must be repaid with interest. Loans from the federal government typically have a lower interest rate than loans from private lenders. Federal loans, listed from most advantageous to least advantageous, are called Direct Subsidized Loans, Direct Unsubsidized Loans, and Direct PLUS Loans. Graduation Rate

Percentage of full-time students who graduate within 6 years - 59.9%

Loan Default Rate: Percent-age of borrowers entering repayment and defaulting on their loan - 4.2%

Median Borrowing: Students at The College of Saint Rose typically borrow \$23,250 in federal loans for their undergraduate study.
