Assistant Professor of Social Work

The College of Saint Rose, an Albany County four year undergraduate and graduate education institution, seeks an Assistant Professor of Social Work.

JOB DUTIES: Full-time tenure track position. Teach twelve (12) credits per semester of undergraduate courses in Social Worker from within the curriculum, such as Introduction to Social Work, Societies / Social Welfare, Social Change and Social Services, Human Behavior Social Environment, Child Abuse and Maltreatment, Family Violence, Community Practice, Alcohol Abuse, Substance Abuse, Depression and Treatment, International Social Work, Diversity Workshop, Substance Abuse, Research Methods, and Family Dynamics. Additional responsibilities include contributing to the continuing development and refinement of the Social Work program, engaging in scholarship, attending internal and external events applicable to the College and the candidate's academic discipline, academic advising, program assessment, curriculum development, and participation in Department, School and College committees.

JOB REQUIREMENTS: The successful candidate will have a D.S.W. or Ph.D. from an accredited institution in Social Work, or a closely related academic field, at the time of appointment. The candidate must also hold of Masters of Social Work from a CSWE accredited institution.

An ABD (D.S.W. or Ph.D.) from an accredited institution in Social Work, or a closely related academic field, will be considered if the degree will be completed from 1 year from the date of appointment.

Additional requirements include a minimum of five years of experience in the field of social work; a demonstrated commitment to excellence in teaching, a record of scholarly work or professional impact in the field of social work, and superior written and oral communications skills. Higher education teaching is required.
